



1.a belief or doctrine that inherent differences among the various human races determine cultural or individual achievement, usually involving the idea that one's own race is superior and has the right to rule others.









Ok with the Lord, Ok with me ...


















CURSE


MOSES 7:8,22- The words "blackness" and "black" both get new footnotes which lead to 2 Nephi 26:33.

THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS

An excerpt from the March 1, 2013 addition to Official Declaration 2

... During Joseph Smith's lifetime, a few black male members of the Church were ordained to the priesthood. Early in its history, Church leaders stopped conferring the priesthood on black males of African descent. Church records offer no clear insights

into the origins of this practice.

What qualifies one for priesthood?

And <u>afaith</u>, <u>bhope</u>, <u>charity</u> and <u>dlove</u>, with an <u>eye</u> single to the <u>fglory</u> of God,

gqualify him for the work.

And this commandment shall be given unto the elders of my church, that every man which will aembrace it with beingleness of heart may be ordained and sent forth, even as I have spoken.

Clear guidance on priesthood repeated

And again, verily I say unto you, athose who desire in their hearts, in meekness, to bwarn sinners to repentance, let them be ordained unto this power.

D&C 121:21-23

- 21 They shall not have right to the apriesthood, nor their posterity after them from generation to generation.
- 22 It had been abetter for them that a millstone had been hanged about their necks, and they drowned in the depth of the sea.
- 23 Wo unto all those that adiscomfort my people, and drive, and bmurder, and testify against them, saith the Lord of Hosts; a generation of vipers shall not escape the damnation of hell.

However, the Lords, speaking of the same people:

And I will answer ajudgment, wrath, and indignation, wailing, and anguish, and gnashing of teeth upon their heads, unto the third and fourth generation, so long as they repent not, and hate me, saith the Lord your God.
